THE ORIGIN OF CLASSICAL EPIGRAVETTIAN OF THE EASTERN EUROPE

According to researches of the author the total Eastern Gravettian (in all its variety) was the general base in an origin of Epigravettian of the Central Europe and Eastern Europe. Epigravettian expressed by two variants – classical and eastern. In article the conclusion is drawn that cultural-historical base in an origin of all Classical Epigravettian of the Eastern Europe was Eastern Gravettian of the region of Ukrainian Sub-Carpathian in a total kind. It was association traditions of several version of Gravettian Villendorf-Kostenki type with traditions of Eastern Gravettian of Pavlov type. Small participation in this process possibly had and Late Molodove archaeological culture.

Small exception, in the offered cultural-historical reconstruction – the origin of Classical Epigravettian of the Eastern Roumania. Where Classical Epigravettian have developed directly on base of Eastern Gravettian, which spreaded here from the region of Ukrainian Sub-Carpathian.
