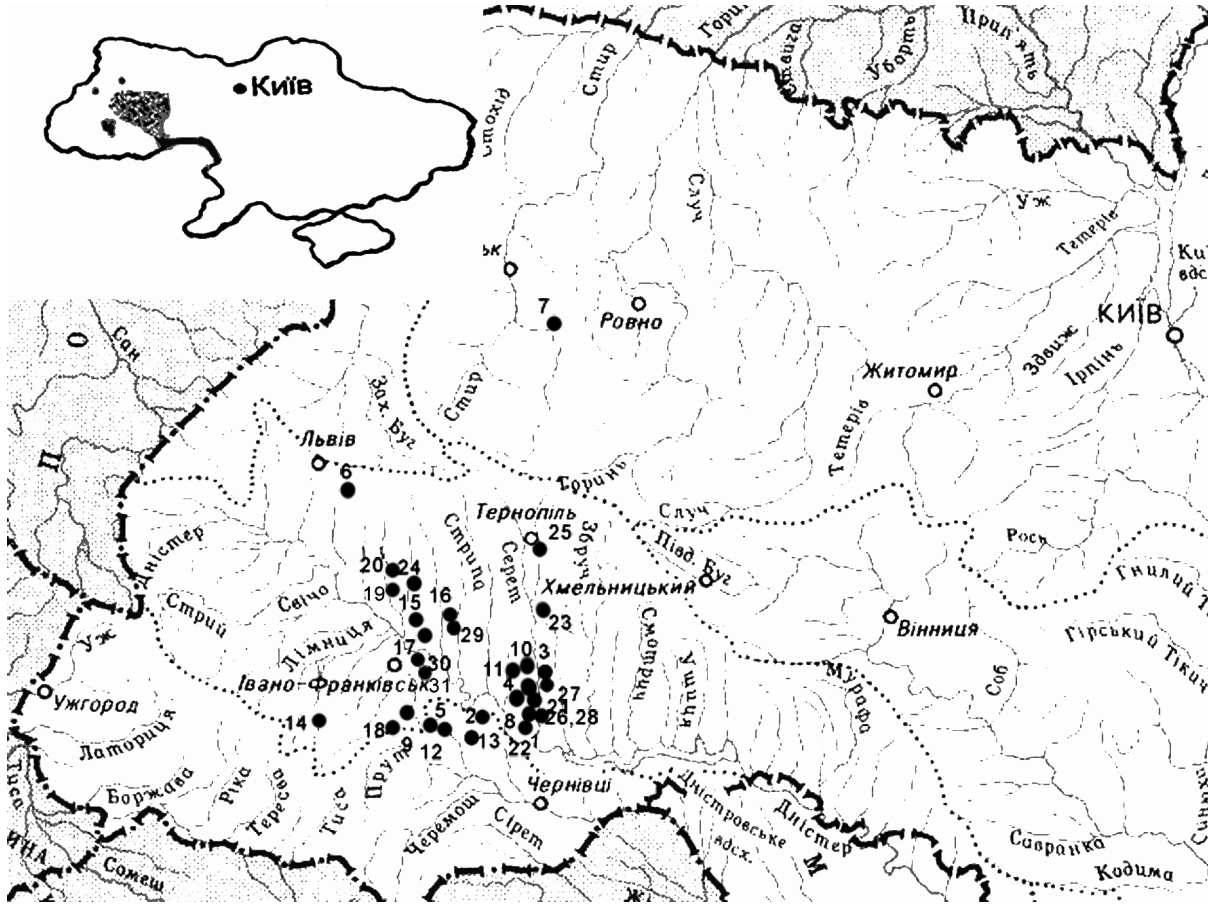





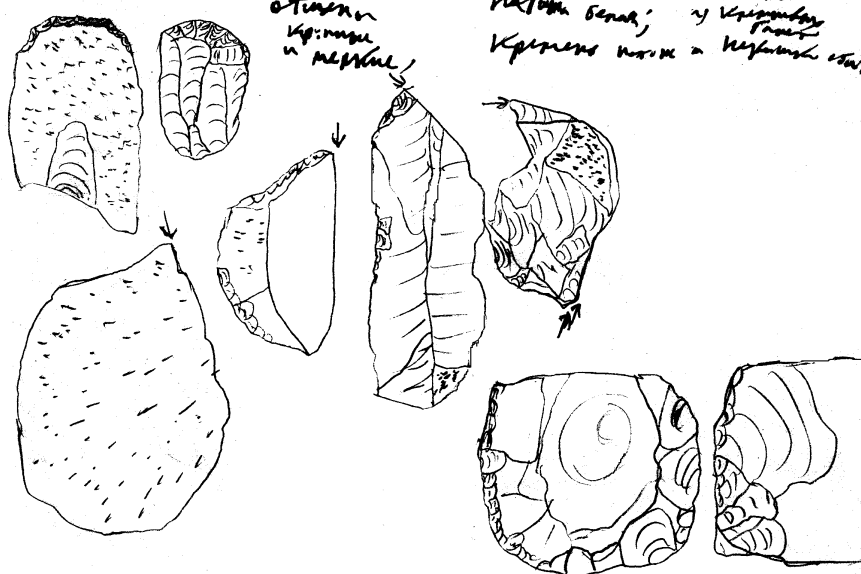


Fig. 3. Page of draft notes made by O. Chernysh (copy from the original).

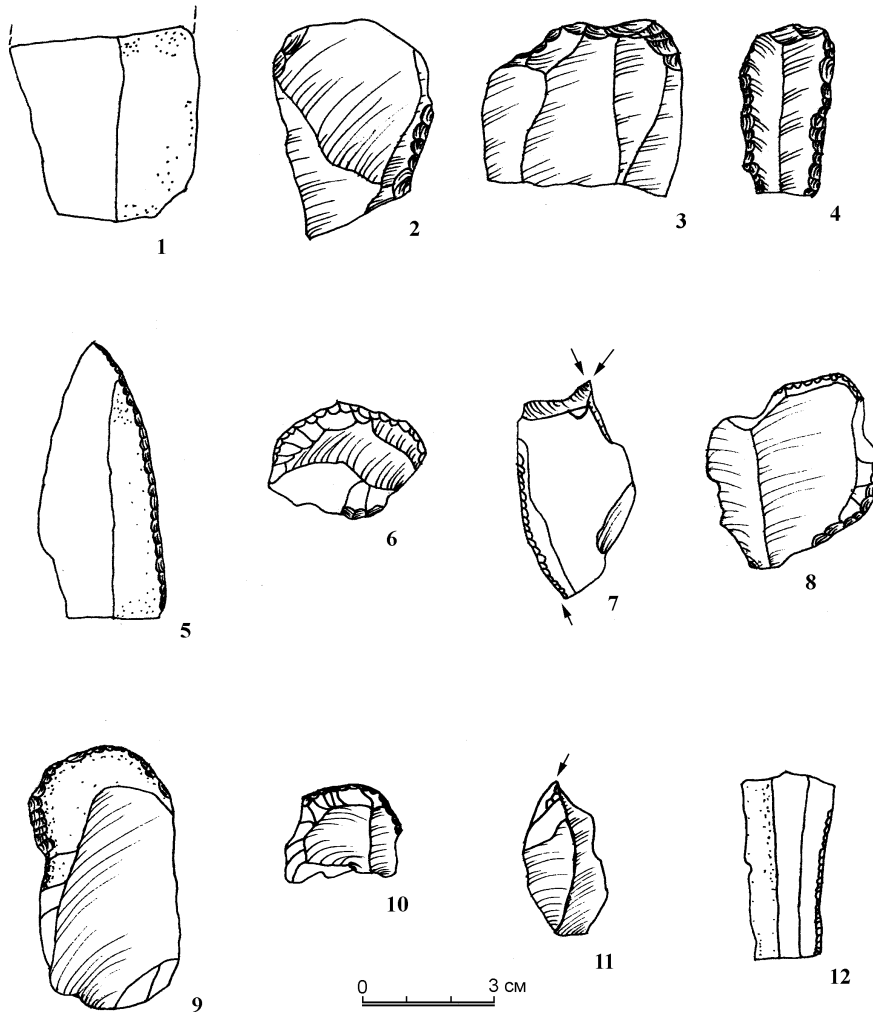


Fig. 4. Flint artifacts. 1, 2 – Kulakivtsi; 3, 4 – Bilche Zolote; 5 – Lysychnyky II; 6 – Oleshiv; 7, 8 – Lypa; 9 – Bukivna (Pid Zarubom Place); 10, 11 – Krasne; 12 – Pochapy.

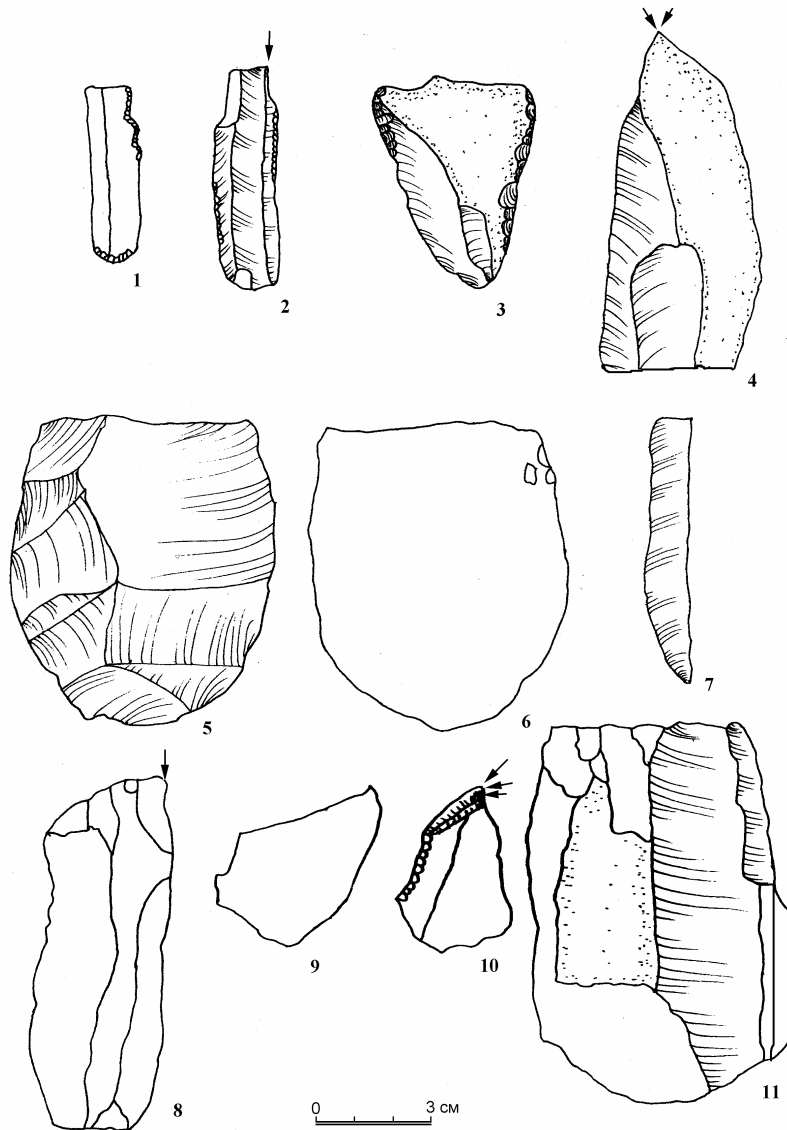

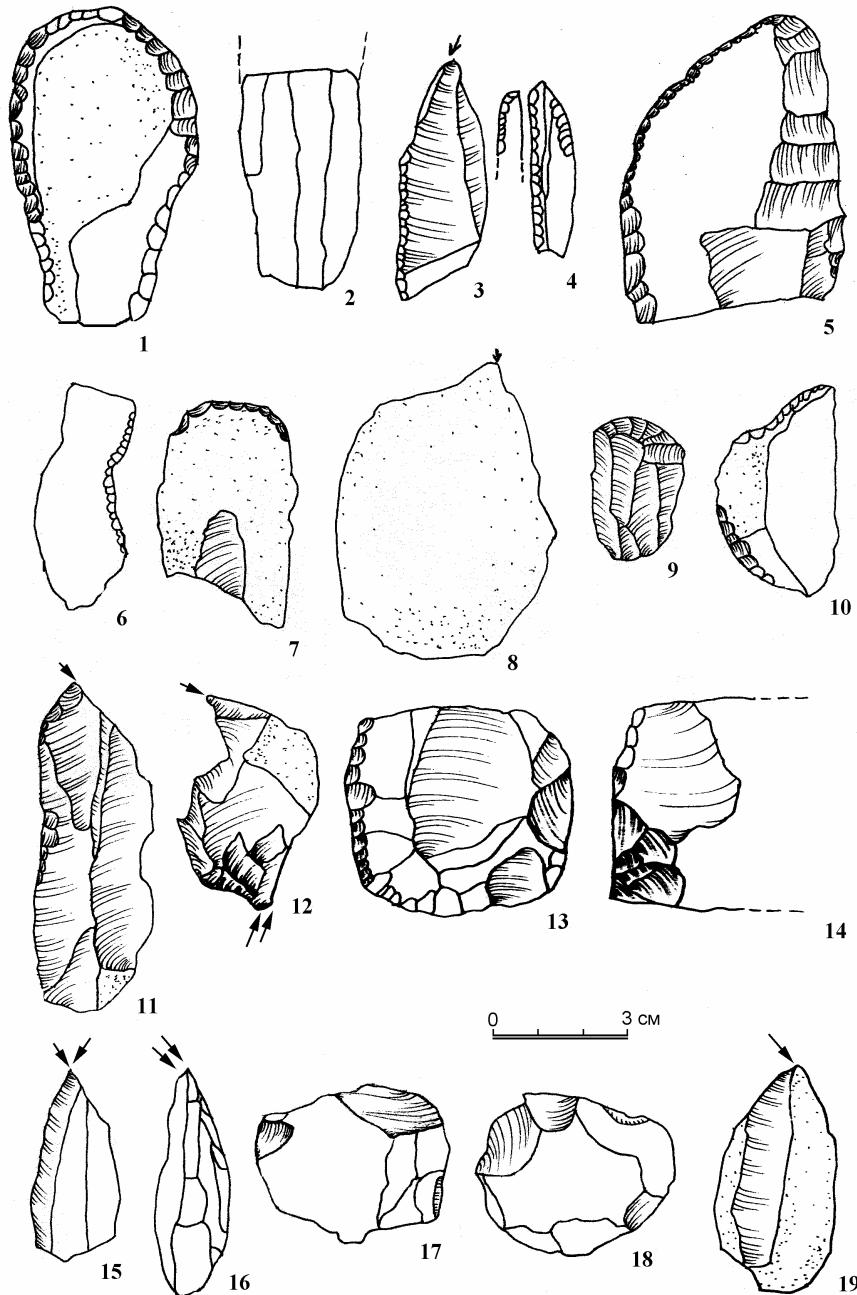


Fig. 6. Flint artifacts. 1 – Lypytsja Gorishnja; 2, 3 – Nyzhnja Lypytsja; 4–6 – Kasperivtsi; 7 – Ustechko; 8–14 – Dolyna; 15, 16 – Krasne; 17, 18 – Goljatyn; 19 – Bogorodycha.

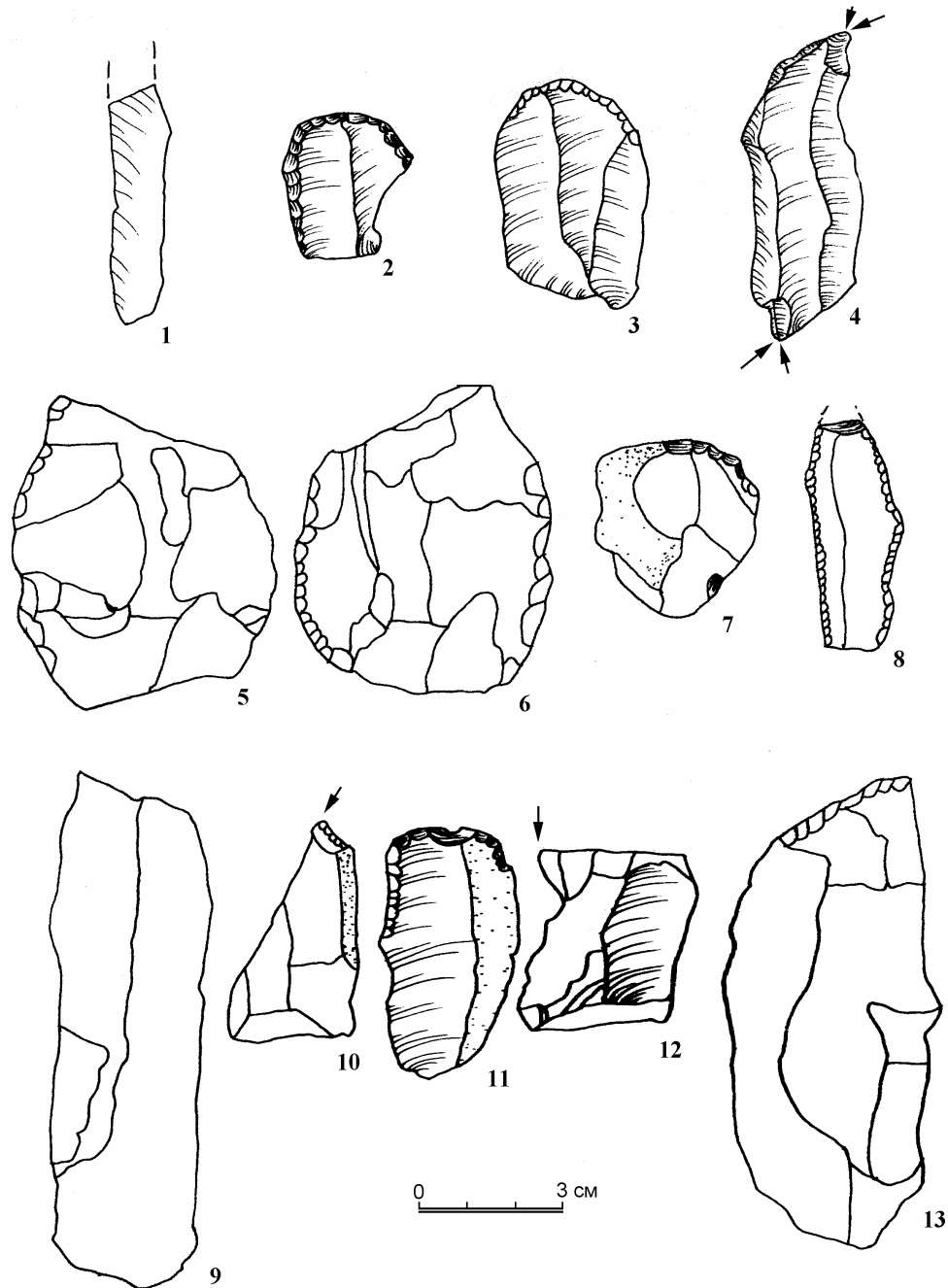


Fig. 7. Flint artifacts. 1-6 - Ustja-Zelene; 7, 8 - Ustechko; 9-13 - Rozhniv.

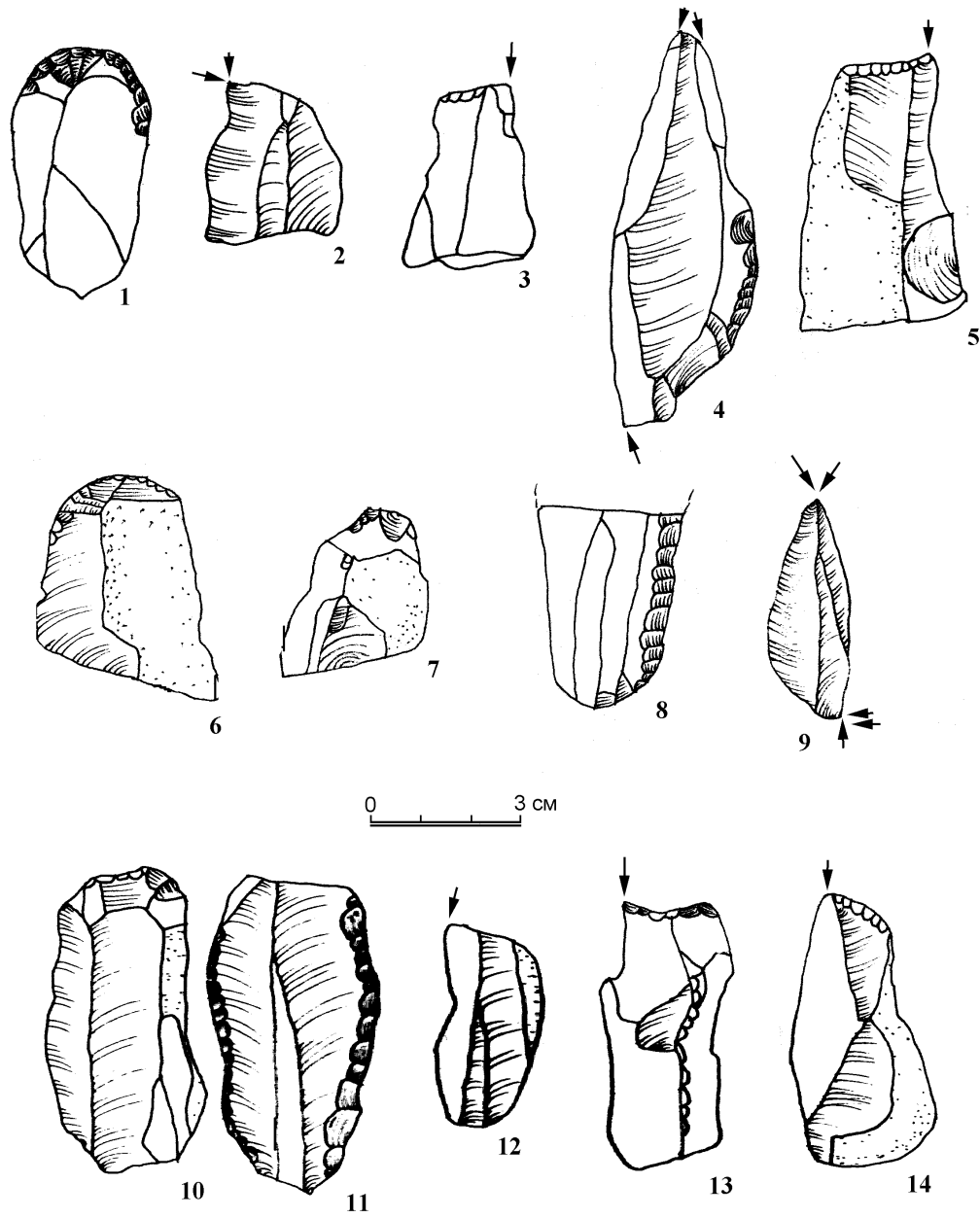


Fig. 8. Flint artifacts. Dovge.
